Who We Are: The Professional Basketball Combine is a secondary NBA draft combine designed to give players an opportunity to work out, do combine testing and interview for NBA GMs, NBA scouts and G-League personnel. Our objective is to provide an opportunity for players to make the most informed decision about their basketball future while receiving exposure to decision makers in professional basketball.

Based on performance throughout the college basketball season, there will be a chance to be invited to come and work the PBC in May 2020. Details will be shared during your experience.

Job Description: Reporting directly to the Director of Scouting, the Scouting Intern(s) will be responsible for performing in-depth, value-add research on prospects that project as potential PBC invitees.

Main Responsibilities:

- Regularly produce comprehensive scouting reports (1-2 per week) on prospects that fit the criteria set forth by the Director of Scouting.
- Cut and edit film to highlight translatable skill sets of featured prospects.
- Perform grassroots outreach to prominent figures (coaches, teammates, media personalities, influential social media accounts, etc.) within featured prospects' local markets in advance of scouting report releases, PBC player announcements, etc.
- Maintain and update the PBC NBA Draft prospect database based on intel gathered, releases of consensus big board rankings, injuries, agent signings, post-season event invitations, early entrant declarations, measurements, etc.

- Must be an excellent communicator
- Must have a desire to learn and have a positive attitude
- Must be able to complete quality work on deadline
- Must love the game of basketball
- Intermediate Microsoft Excel experience (preferred)
- Data scraping experience (preferred)
